It's all up hill from here!

The Knox Mountain Hillclimb is the oldest paved Hillclimb in North America now running in its 51st year.

So what's so special about it you may ask? This is the purest form of Motorsport you will find; just you and your car against the Hill and the clock; any serious mistakes are usually rewarded with a free excursion down the mountain side; no run off areas or safety barriers at Knox.

I first ran Knox in 1975 in my Can-am car and set a Hill record of 1.54 seconds which stood for many years. I returned to Knox in 2005 in one of our road-going Caterham Super 7 Hayabusa cars and posted a 1.58, maybe this year I can equal my time of 33 years ago. Any time under 2 minutes is seriously quick and will only be achieved by the super brave. This event is not for the faint hearted!

The whole town of Kelowna is behind this amazing event and closes the Provincial Park to enable the Hillclimb to take place. There are some spectacular viewing spots, but be prepared for a bit of a climb up the Mountain. You wont regret it.

Each year the organizers do an excellent job, priding themselves with a well run, friendly and laid back event where one can amble through the pits, talk with the drivers and crews and enjoy Canadian club racing at its very best.

Kelowna is set in the beautiful Okanagan Valley and has some truly fabulous roads for driving your 7.

This is an event NOT to be missed and I really look forward to meeting you all at the club's 1st National gathering here in Canada.
